1960 Chrysler Windsor Convertible

An example of the first year of UNIBODY construction for Chrysler, this was a one owner California car until 1996. It has been restored to the original Chrysler color of "Lilac" which was offered for the 1960 models. Only 1467 Windsor convertibles were built; this was the last production year for Windsor convertibles. Walter P. Chrysler Club records indicate that 10 examples remain today (four in Sweden and Finland!).

Powered by a 305hp 383 cubic inch V-8 motor, this example is equipped with push button automatic transmission, power steering, power brakes, and sport deck lid option. On the old NASCAR circuit this option was referred to as a "toilet seat lid".



The original cost of this 3855 lb. finned wonder was \$3,568 plus options. The 1960 models with sweeping front to rear tail fins and boomerang taillights give this unique vehicle a special place in MOPAR collector's dreams.
